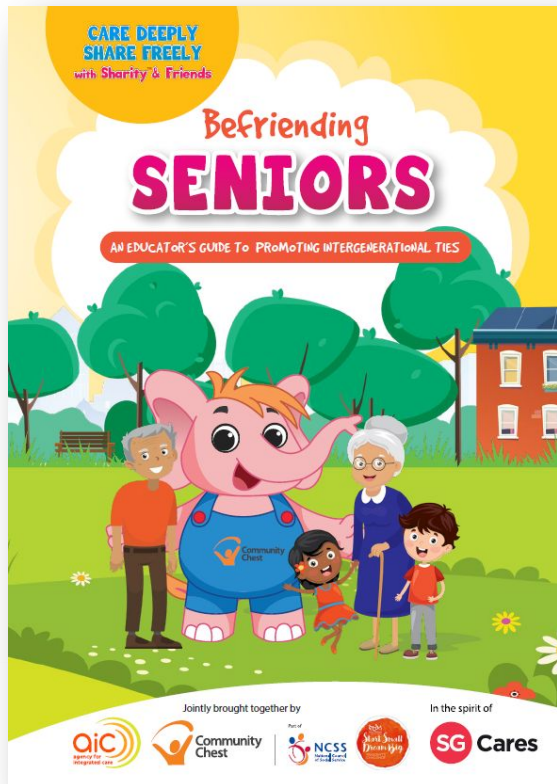

After a show-and-tell session about being kind to others, the children decided to embark on a project on caring for the elderly. The centre collaborated with the Agency for Integrated Care (AIC) and Community Chest, and connected with the seniors from St. Andrew's Nursing Home (Taman Jurong) and All Saints Home (Jurong East). The children came up with board games for the seniors to enjoy, and parents chipped in by donating dry food items.

“This year marks the first collaboration between AIC and Community Chest supporting pre-schools under SSDB. Due to safe-distancing measures, physical visits to senior care facilities were not possible. However, this did not deter the pre-schools from finding ways to engage our seniors in nursing homes. They participated in the activity “Walk in My Shoes” where they were challenged to walk with one foot, find objects without using their sight, relay a message to their friends without speaking, and read a piece of paper with scrambled words. Through these activities, they experienced the challenges that other children with disabilities face.
