## Community Outreach



Reach out to the community to spread what was learnt and instil urgency in taking action now to contribute to water sustainability.

## Reflection Activities

Reflect on what gleaned from the past weeks and consolidate learnings (reflection mural, in-class Q&A, submit resolutions to improve LPCD).

To allow students to understand the term LPCD and raise awareness on the national target of 130 LPCD. Students to calculate their very own LPCD using a water calculator on the campaign microsite.

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## Week 1



### **PLAN:**

Students learn about climate change and the pressing need to protect our water resources

## Week 2



### **PARTICIPATE:**

Staff and students take a proactive stance to understand their water consumption habits and take action to instil positive water saving habits in their daily lives.

## Week 3



### **PROGRESS:**

Students reflect on their past activities and share their knowledge with their peers and families.

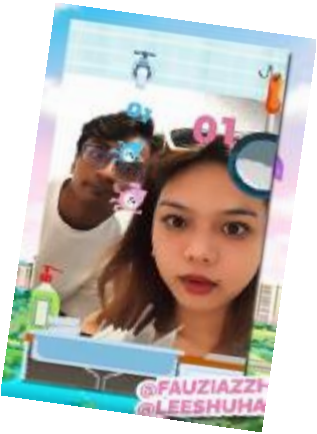


