ARTIST HIGHLIGHT – JASON WEE





Self-Portrait (No More Years, Mr. Lee), 2009 Jason Wee

Self-Portrait (No More Tears, Mr. Lee) is a large scale installation created with 8,000 plastic shampoo bottle caps created by Singaporean artist Jason Wee. He deconstructs an image into pixels and recreated the image into a portrait made using the shampoo bottle caps. The artist chose to create this portrait to remind Singaporeans of Mr Lee's contributions to Singapore.
