Timmy's water adventure through time



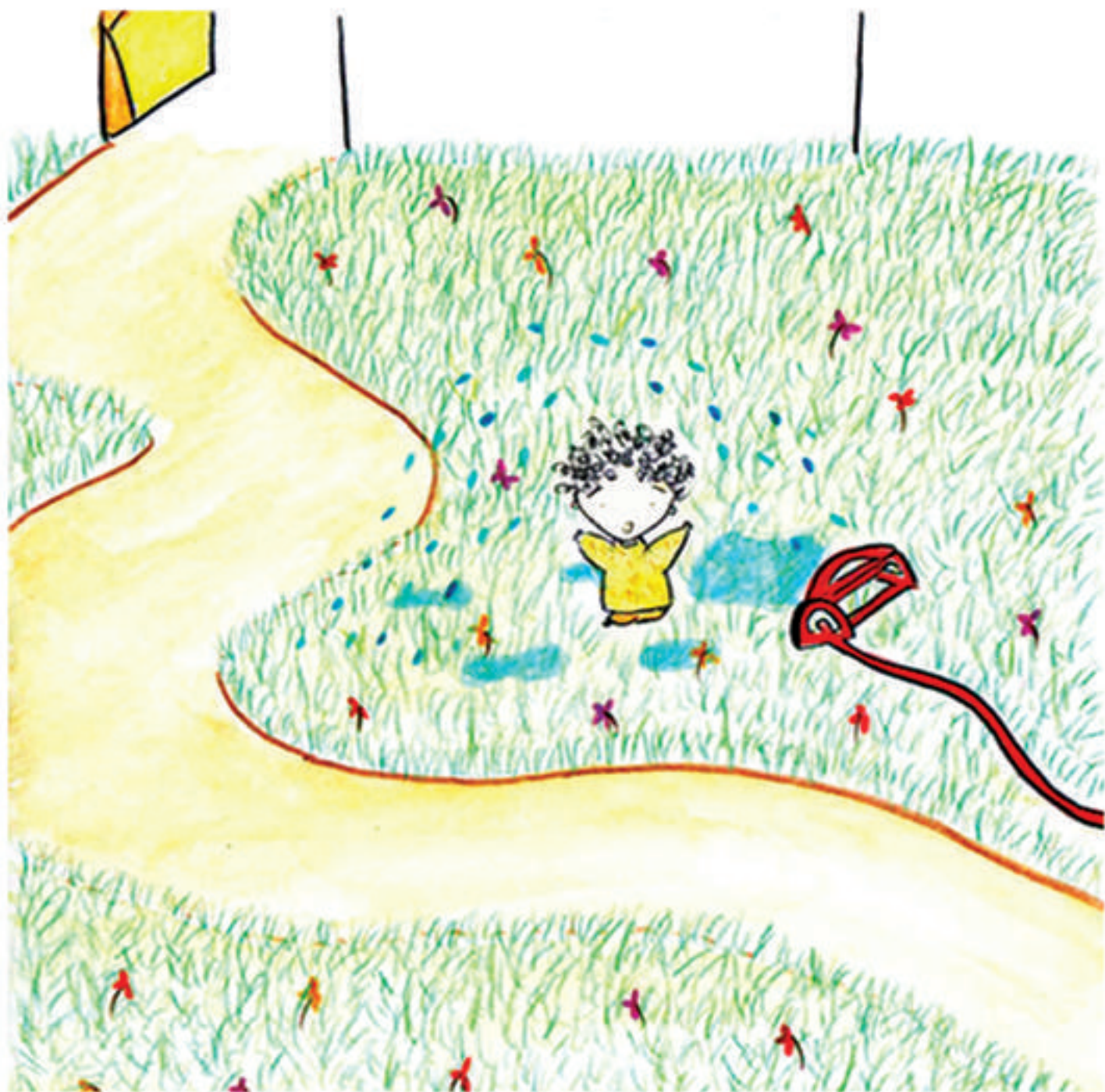

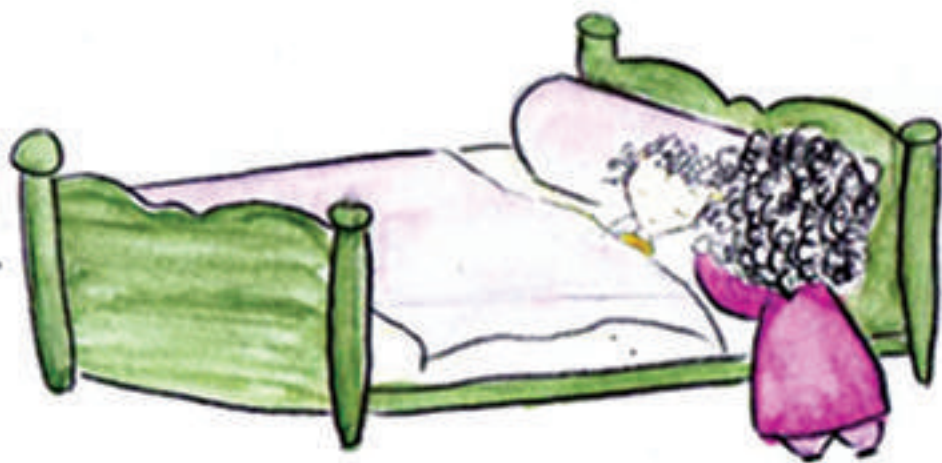
When brushing his teeth, Timmy loves to leave the tap running as he listens to the sound of dripping water.



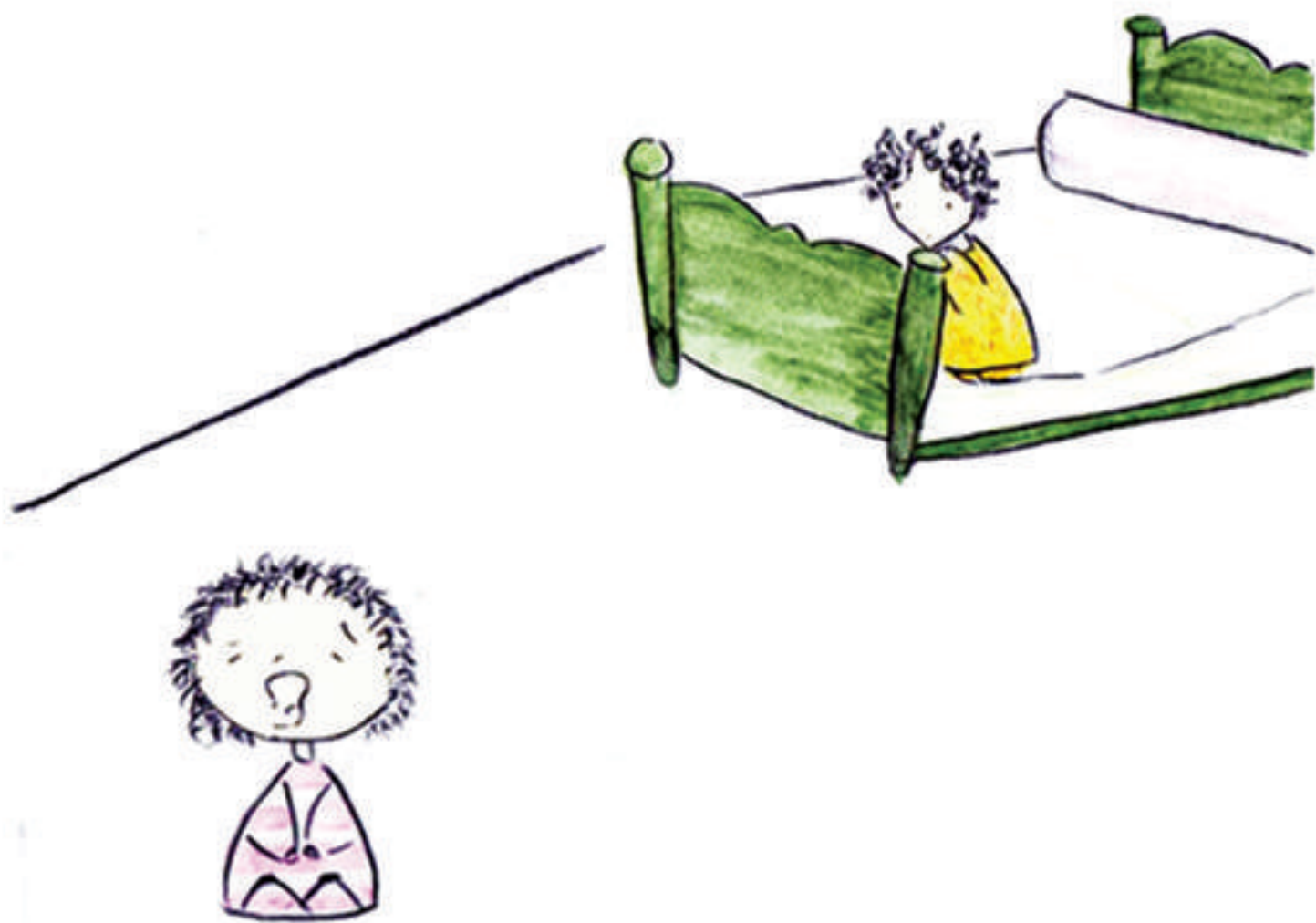
When taking a bath, Timmy likes to overfill the bathtub as he pretends to be a pirate out in the storm!
