Through tiny tweaks to their daily routines, children can take action by exploring and understanding some of the possible effects of our daily actions on the marine community, and co-create or realise ideas to protect the marine animals and their homes.

Educator Resource Guide Phase 1



- Introduce poster to the children recommended to print it out on four A3-sized papers.
- Allow children to explore the illustrations on poster.
 - o Tip 1: Provide children with magnifying glasses to spot characters.
 - o Tip 2: Play the "I spy" game with children while exploring the illustrations.

Phase 2



- Using the Let's Explore activity card, invite children to predict or ask questions:
 - o What is the diver doing?
 - o I think the submarine is going to pick all the litter up.
 - o What is that animal hiding in the shipwreck?
 - o The little boy threw the rubbish into the ocean because there is no dustbin nearby.
- Pick questions / predictions and turn them into topics for discussion in subsequent lessons.





- Using the Take Action! activity card, encourage children to pen down ideas to solve the environmental issues or to find out more about the marine animals!
- Take action and make the ocean a better place!
