REDUCE PLASTIC WASTE, SAVE THE WATERY CREATURES

Every minute, an equivalent of one truck full of plastic waste is dumped into our oceans. Each year, about 1 million animals die because of plastic waste. Sea turtles accidentally swallow plastic pieces which block their digestive systems, otters get strangled by plastic bags, sea birds often pick up plastic pieces together with the fish they consume...the list goes on.

How can your students help?

- Learn how animals are affected by plastic waste.
- Use refillable water bottles to reduce the use of disposable plastic products.
- Share their knowledge with others in creative ways!
